Have you ever heard of the powerful, fire-breathing creatures called dragons? Did these creatures really exist or did they originate in someone's imagination?

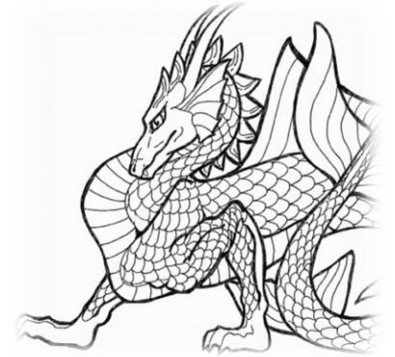

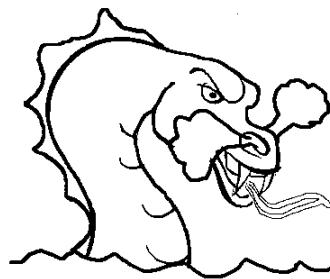
