**Bible Reading** 1Co 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

1Co 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Col 2:16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Col 2:17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the

body is of Christ

*1Co 11:23 For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:*

*1Co 11:24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.*

*1Co 11:25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.*

*1Co 11:26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.*

Exo 12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this {first} month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

Exo 12:6 And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

Exo 12:7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Exo 12:8 And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

Exo 12:9 Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast with fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof.

Exo 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover.

The Passover lamb was to be selected on the \_\_\_\_\_  
day of the \_\_\_\_\_ month. Ex. 12: 3,6

It was to be without \_\_\_\_\_. Ex.12:5 This was to  
represent Jesus who also was the \_\_\_\_\_ of God. He had  
not spot or sin in Him. Hebrews 9:13,14; 1 Peter 1:18,19

When the lamb was slain on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month the  
blood from the lamb was caught in a basin and a small bunch of  
hyssop was dipped into it and used to mark the  
\_\_\_\_\_ of each home. Ex. 12:7,22 \_\_\_\_\_  
symbolized purification from sin. Psalm 51:7  
Jesus died on the cross on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month just like  
the passover lamb.

The Israelites were required to separate themselves from the  
Egyptians and gather in their own homes. The firstborn in the  
homes sprinkled with blood were protected from the destroying  
angel. Ex. 12;7,12,13,22

We too, are to come out and be \_\_\_\_\_. 2 Cor. 6:17  
We must separate from sin and the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus  
will protect us. 1 John 1:7,9

The lamb was to be eaten roasted and not a bone of it was to be  
\_\_\_\_\_. Ex. 12:8,46  
Not a bone of Jesus body was broken. John 19:31-36

The lamb was eaten with \_\_\_\_\_ herbs to remind them of  
their cruel bondage in Egypt. Ex. 12:8, PP 278 We also are to  
leave sin behind us.

They were to eat the supper with their loins  
\_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ on their feet and \_\_\_\_\_  
in their hands. Ex. 12:11

We are to have our loins girt about with \_\_\_\_\_ and  
have on all the \_\_\_\_\_ of God. Eph. 6:10-17
