

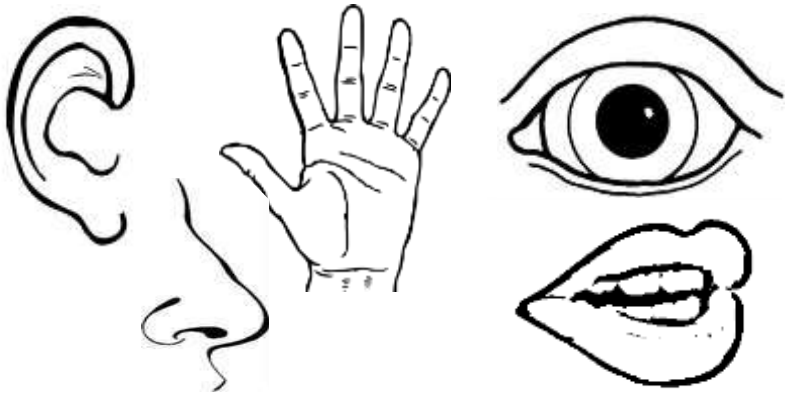
When we _____ God's _____ nothing will offend (cause to fall) us. Psalm 119:165

Color pictures of the 5 senses we should guard to protect our body temple, especially our mind, from evil.



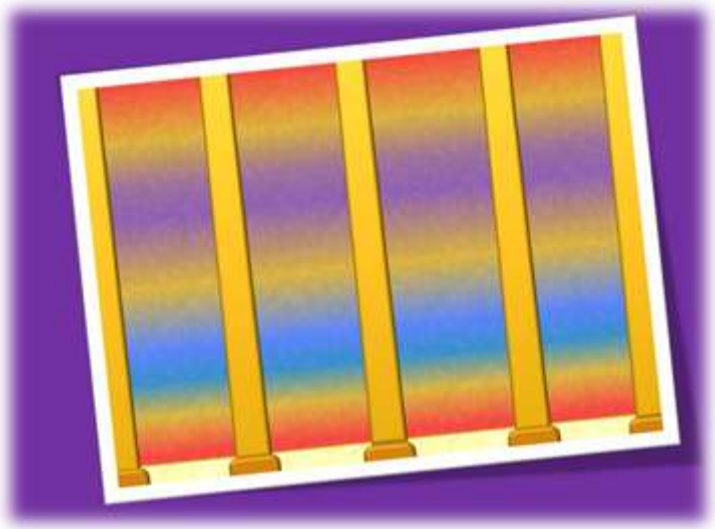
All should guard the senses lest Satan gain victory over them for these are the avenues to the soul. 3 T pg 507

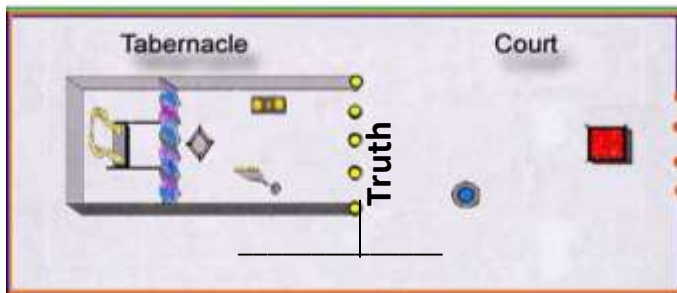
Exo 36:37 And he made an hanging for the tabernacle door of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, of needlework;
