Automaton

AUTOM'ATION, n. [*Gr. self. The Greek plural, automata, is sometimes used; but the regular English plural, automatons, is preferable.*]

A self-moving machine, or one which moves by invisible springs.

Conformity

Likeness; correspondence with a model in form or manner; resemblance; agreement; congruity with something else; followed by to or with.

Constraining

Urging with irresistible or powerful force; compelling; forcing; repressing; confining; holding by force; pressing; binding.

Impart

To give, grant or communicate; to bestow on another a share or portion of something; as, to impart a portion of provisions to the poor.

To grant; to give; to confer; as, to impart honor or favor.

To communicate the knowledge of something; to make known; to show by words or tokens.

Yield

To allow; To give; To permit; to grant; To surrender; To comply with; To give way; not to oppose.
