A Christian man's deportment is outlined in the following verses: Titus 2:2, 6,7; 1 Cor. 16:13

A Christian Youth's deportment: 1Tim. 4:12; Lam. 3:27; Eccl. 12:1



The true Christian will seek for inward adornment in their heart rather than outward adornment. Their clothing will be modest, avoiding varying states of nakedness. Yet, their dress will be clean and tidy. They will avoid jewelry, makeup, elaborate hairstyles, expensive clothing, as well as avoiding clothing and hair styles that resemble the opposite gender.
