

Besides the obvious meaning of gospel, which includes the plan of salvation, the good news about Jesus birth, life, death, resurrection and mediatorial work, Webster's 1828 Dictionary also defines the gospel as: 1. God's word. 3. Any general doctrine. Thus the entire Bible must be given to the entire world.

"To be "instant in season" is to be alert to the privileges of the house and hour of worship, and to the times when men are conversing on topics of religion. And to be instant "out of season" is to be ready, when at the fireside, in the field, by the wayside, in the market, to turn the minds of men, in a suitable manner, to the great themes of the Bible" Evangelism, page 430			
Proverbs 3:27, 28 "Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it. Say not unto thy neighbour, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee." (2 Cor. 6:2)			
We are to withhold good when we have the to do it. The word gospel means "a good message" so this verse also tells us that when we know the truth we are obligated to share it with others. This includes sharing the gospel with your friends, relatives, neighbors and other people all over the world.			
John 20:21 "Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as			
my Father hath sent me, even so send I you." John 4:34 "Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work."			
Jesus said He sends us as His Father Him. This means that in our missionary work we should imitate Christ's methods of evangelism. (Matt. 4:23; Matt. 9:35) "Christ's method alone will give true success in reaching the people. The Saviour mingled with men as one who desired their good. He showed His sympathy for them, ministered to their needs, and won their confidence. Then He bade them, "Follow Me." Ministry of Healing, p. 143
