This means that in our missionary work we should imitate Christ's methods of evangelism. (Matt. 4:23; Matt. 9:35)

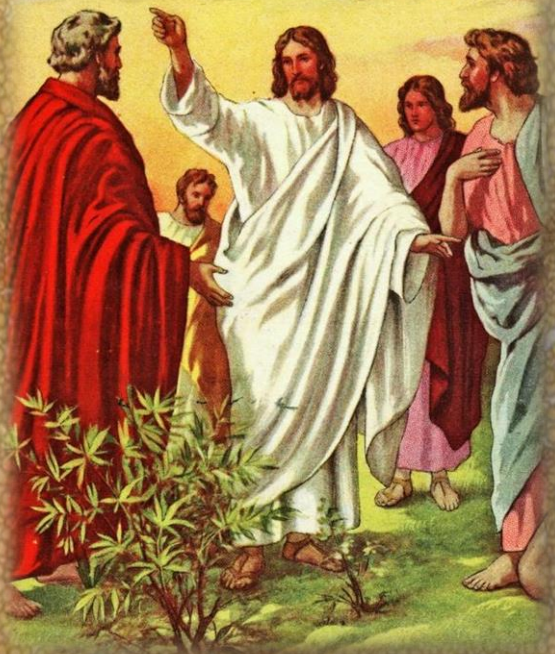
