Notice that the first of these 3 members is referred to as "the Father." He is likened to a Father, so that we can understand his role or position that he holds. When we think of a "father figure" we usually think of someone who is the head of the household, the leader or the one in charge; he is the one who is considered the protector of the children and the family.

Now this can give you some idea of God the father's role, however, it is not quite accurate when viewed from a human perspective because each member of the Godhead has the same authority as the others. Yet, because of their unselfish nature, they all point humans to the other members.

The Bible shows that the members of the Godhead all give to the other members.
1 Cor. 8:6 But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. John 14:9-17 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in meAnd I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth;"
