SALVATION AND CONVERSION

Have you received the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour for **salvation from sin**, for **a real change of heart**, and will you **permit Him by the Holy Spirit to live in you** daily? John 1:12,13; Gal. 2:20.

REPENTANCE

Have you repented of, and confessed all known sin to God, and do you believe that He, for Christ's sake has forgiven you, and as far as possible have you tried to make matters right with your fellow men? 1 John 1:9; Matt.5:23-26; Eze.33:15.

THE 10 COMMANDMENTS AND THE SABBATH

Is it your purpose, by the grace of God, to live a true Christian life, by surrendering all soul, body, spirit to God, to do His will in all things and keep the commandments of God? Rom. 12:1; Col. 3:17; Revelation.14:12.

SOUL WINNING

Will you seek to maintain a true spiritual experience by the daily study of God's Word and prayer, and *will you endeavor by*your consistent life and personal effort to win souls to Christ? Matthew 28:19, 20; 2 Timothy 2:15

THE THREE ANGEL'S MESSAGES

Do you believe the closing gospel message of the three angels and that it is time to "Fear God."; worship the Creator (who made the earth in six literal days); Come out of Babylon; and the other kindred truths that comprise the special message of Revelation 14:6-12? Rev. 18:1-5; Genesis 1:1-31; Ex. 20:8-11

TITHES AND OFFERINGS

Will you practice the Bible plan *for the support of God's work* by rendering unto Him first the tithe, or one tenth of all your increase (Lev. 27:30; Mal. 3:8-10); and then offerings as you may be able, according to His prospering hand? Deut. 16:17; Luke 6:38.

THE LAWS OF HEALTH

Is it your purpose to obey the command to eat and drink to the glory of God (1 Cor. 10:31) by abstaining from all intoxicating liquors (Pro. 23:29-32), tobacco in all its forms (1 Cor. 3:16, 17), swine's flesh (Isa. 66:15, 17), unclean meats, *narcotics, drugs, tea*, *coffee*, and other harmful things?

DRESS AND ATTIRE

Are you willing to follow the Bible rule of modesty, gender appropriateness, and simplicity of dress, refraining from the wearing of earrings, necklaces, bracelets, extravagant hairstyles, rings, cosmetics, costly array, etc., and from any lack of dress that is out of keeping with the Bible rule of modesty? 1 Tim. 2:9, 10; 1 Peter 3:3, 4; Ex. 33:5, 6; Gen. 35:2-4; Deut. 22:5.

THE LORD'S SUPPER AND THE ORDINANCE OF HUMILITY

Do you believe in and have you accepted the ordinance of humility (John 13:1-17), and the ordinance of the Lord's Supper? 1 Cor. 11:23-33.

WORLDLINESS

Is it your purpose to come out from the world and be separate in obedience to God's command in 2 Cor. 6:17, by refraining from following *the sinful practices of the world*, such as dancing, worldly music, card-playing, theater-going, novel reading, etc. and by shunning all questionable worldly amusements? 1 John 2:15; James 1:27; 4:4.

THE SPIRIT OF PROPHECY - ELLEN G. WHITE

Do you recognize that the remnant has the Spirit of Prophecy, and that this has been manifested *through the writings of Ellen G. White*? Rev. 12:17; 19:10.

DEATH AND RESURRECTION

Do you believe in immortality only through Christ (2 Tim. 1:10); and that the **condition of man in death** is one of unconsciousness -- that men good and evil alike remain in the grave until the resurrection? Eccl. 9:5, 6; Daniel. 12:2; 1 Thess. 4:13,16,17

SANCTUARY

Do you believe that God's way is revealed in the sanctuary and that since 1844 we have been living in the time period of the **cleansing of the sanctuary in heaven**, also referred to as the Anti-typical Day of Atonement? Daniel 8:14; Psa. 77:13; Lev. 16:2, 29

A RIGHTEOUS JUDGE

Do you believe in the eternal destruction of the wicked (Malachi 4:1-4) at the close of the millennium and that God is a loving, righteous judge who is long-suffering, "not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance"? Jude 7, 2 Peter 3:9, 2 Peter 2:6, Eze. 33:11, Rev. 20:2-7

SECOND COMING OF CHRIST

Do you believe and accept the great truths of the Word of God concerning the personal, visible, literal, imminent return of Christ (Acts 1:9-11) and do you look forward to the **soon coming of Jesus** and the Blessed Hope, when this "mortal shall... put on immortality"? John 14:1-3; Rev. 1:7; Acts. 1:9-11

BAPTISM

Do you believe in baptism by immersion only, and *are you ready to follow your Lord and Master* in this sacred rite? Matt. 28:18-20; Col. 2:12; Rom. 6:3-5.
