About 30 years ago I began to see parts of the Bible that I could not understand. As an example, "casting bread on water and finding it many days later", (Eccl. 11:1) did not make sense to me. "Always wearing white clothes and keeping oil on my head" (Eccl. 9:8) didn't make any sense either. I began a dilligent search to try to find someone to help me understand the Bible. To make a long story very short, I received the most help from the Bible itself.

I began to read statements in the Bible about the "hidden treasure" of the Bible. By studying the parables I saw how Jesus revealed truth by using real objects and giving them each a Spiritual meaning. I began to realize that many parts of the Bible are not meant to make literal or physical sense, but are meant to be understood Spiritually. The Bible became its own interpreter for me and I saw that one verse of the Bible was the key to understanding another verse of the Bible. I began compiling a list of the Spiritual meanings of the objects used in the Bible and found to my great joy, that I was able to understand parts of the Bible that previously had not made sense to me.

Soon, I was sharing what I had learned with anyone who would listen. I found that friends who would not listen to "straight doctrine" were intrigued by how the Bible explained itself and would listen to the parables and their explanation. I started to write books to make the Bible simple so that my friends could understand it. These were not books about the Bible, but books that let you understand the Bible yourself!

Most people are "surface readers" and have no idea of what they are missing by not understanding the "hidden wisdom" in the Bible. On the following pages you will discover like never before the beauty and depth of the Bible as you discover its meaning that is hidden from the "surface seeker". Best of all you will fall in love with Jesus as you really begin to understand the Bible!

# How To Understand Our Father's Words

# Principles For Bible Study

# Study Principle 1 Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide you as you study

the Bible and search for truth.

# Study Principle 2

Let the **Bible** explain itself.

One text will prove to be a key that will unlock other texts, and in this way you will discover the hidden meaning of God's Word.

1Cor. 2:13 ..Not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

# USING A CONCORDANCE:

You use a <u>concordance</u> much like a <u>dictionary</u>. The words in a concordance are placed in alphabetical order and the concordance contains <u>every word</u> in the Bible and gives the <u>location or Bible text</u> where each word is found. When you want to explore a <u>topic or subject</u> you simply look up the <u>word</u> that describes your <u>subject</u>, (such as" Angels") in your concordance and then proceed to read the Bible texts the concordance has listed for you.

And when the <u>doctrines</u> (rain) of Christ were challenged by the <u>doctrines</u> (winds) of <u>ungodly</u> <u>men</u> (floods), the <u>Church</u> (house) founded upon the words of <u>Christ</u> (rock) maintained its position (fell not) from the Bible!

Everyone that hears the words of Jesus and <u>does not</u> do what He <u>says</u> is like a <u>foolish man</u> whose <u>Church</u> (house) was built upon the words of <u>men</u> (sand). And when the <u>doctrines</u> (rain) of Christ were challenged by the <u>doctrines</u> (winds) of <u>ungodly men</u> (floods), that <u>Church</u> (house) could not maintain its position from the Bible and great was its fall!

(This Bible verse teaches us the <u>great importance</u> of basing <u>all our beliefs</u> on the <u>words of God</u> (Bible) instead of the <u>words of men</u>.)

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# **Summarizing**




# The Plan of Salvation in the Colors

Just as all Colors are made from the 3 Primary Colors of (Blue, Red, Yellow), everything that exists was made by the 3 Members of the Godhead.


(The Father, Jesus the Son, the Holy Spirit)

Each member of the Godhead is represented by one of the Primary Colors (Blue, Red, Yellow) as well as by one of the Primary Elements of the Plan of Salvation. (Law, Blood, Love)



The combination of the <u>Love</u> of God given to us by the Holy Spirit and the Perfect obedience to God's <u>Law</u> offered to us by Jesus gives us <u>Hope</u> and produces the <u>Fruit</u> of a changed life.

The combination of the Blood of Jesus and His Perfect Life of Obedience to God's Law, gives us the opportunity to become part of God's Royal Family.



We know that everything is in its proper place because of the <u>connection</u> the Bible makes between these <u>specific colors</u> and <u>spiritual things</u>.

We see the <u>3 members of the Godhead</u> and the <u>3 primary Elements of</u> the **Plan of Salvation**:

Law, Love, & Jesus' Blood

Connected to these elements are the <u>3 primary Goals that God has for us</u>:

To have **Hope** and to produce **Fruit**To become **Kings** as part of **His Royal Family**To see Him in **His Glory** 

The way these <u>Goals can be realized</u> is seen and understood by following the lines which connect the primary colors (red, blue, yellow) with the other colors (green, purple, amber). Everything is interdependent, or <u>each depends on the other</u>. Just as there are <u>physical limitations</u>, there are <u>spiritual limitations</u>.

You cannot make green without <u>yellow and blue</u>. Even so, you cannot have <u>Hope</u>, nor produce Fruit, without first having the <u>Love of the Spirit</u> and <u>Gods' 10 Commandment Law</u> written in your heart.

As you cannot make <u>purple</u> without <u>red and blue</u>, even so to become <u>Kings in God's Royal Family</u>, we must first allow <u>Jesus to cleanse us</u> from all unrighteousness, <u>through His Blood</u> and then to believe in <u>His Perfect Life of Obedience</u> in <u>keeping God's Law</u>.

As you cannot make <u>amber</u> without the colors of <u>yellow and red</u>, even so in order to see <u>God's Glory</u>, we must first have the <u>Love of the Holy Spirit</u> in our hearts and be <u>cleansed by Jesus' Blood</u>.

The 3 primary Elements of Salvation:

Law, Love, & Jesus' Blood are supplied by God Himself.

God & His 10 Commandment Law (blue)

(Ezk. 11:20) (Heb. 10:16)

Jesus & His Blood (red)

(John 3:16) (Luke 22:20)

Holy Spirit & His Love (yellow)

(Rom. 5:5) (2 Tim. 1:7)

The 3 primary <u>Goals</u> for us are actually <u>Gifts</u>, which are given to us <u>on condition</u>:

May God help us to "fulfil the conditions", so that we may obtain the "Gifts" that God wants to give us!!!

Now we are beginning to "get the picture". An old garment with "patches" of new garment over the "holes", represents the life or character of a person who is a sinner (old garment) who tries to "patch up" his sinful life with "a little righteousness" (piece of new garment). The result is a sinner who is trying to "look good", but who remains a sinner!

Since the "patch" will not work but tears an even bigger hole in the garment, which reveals even more "nakedness" or sinfulness, the sinner attempts to "work even more righteousness" to cover his now greater sin.

Eventually, the "hole" in the garment becomes so large that in effect there is no garment left and the person is left completely naked!

Thus, a person has only two choices:

1. To become completely "naked".

or

2. To become **completely** "**covered**" with a <u>new garment</u>.

Similarly, the sinner has only two choices:

1. To become completely sinful (naked)

or

2. To become **completely righteous** (covered with new garment)

Now the question is <u>how</u> does the **sinner** become "**completely righteous**" if he <u>can't</u> do it a "little at a time" ("patches")?

The <u>answer</u> is that the <u>sinner</u> must become "<u>completely</u> <u>righteous</u>" all at once! <u>How</u> can this be done? When a "completely <u>naked</u>" person puts on a <u>new garment</u>, they are <u>immediately</u> "completely <u>covered</u>" by the "new garment".

Similarly, when a "completely sinful" person puts on the Robe of Christs Righteousness (new garment) they are immediately "completely covered" by His Righteous life (new garment)! Their "nakedness" or sinfulness is no longer visible!

#### Isaiah 61:10

10 "...My soul shall be joyful in my God for <u>He hath</u> clothed me with the garment of salvation, He hath covered me with the robe of righteousness..."

As far as the judgment is concerned, the person "covered" by the Robe of Christs Righteousness is as perfectly sinless as Christ is!

#### Job 29:14

14 "I put on righteousness, and it clothed me; my judgment was as a robe."

But there is a <u>problem</u> that this parable brings out. The "<u>new garment</u>" cannot be <u>put over the "old garment</u>". It is necessary to get <u>rid</u> of the <u>old garment</u> before you can put on the "new garment"! This illustrates the principle that we cannot continue to <u>hold on</u> to our <u>old sinful life</u> (old garment) and expect <u>Jesus</u> to give us a <u>new life!</u> (new garment). We <u>must allow Jesus</u> to <u>change us</u> and to "take away our filthy garment" or sinfulness.

### The Change of Garments (The Change of Character)

GEN 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

GEN 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. (Adam and Eve were originally "clothed" by God. After they sinned they lost their garments given to them by God.)

GEN 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. (Adam and Eve tried to make "garments" or clothing for themselves.)

GEN 3:21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

(<u>The Lord God made new garments</u> for Adam and Eve and took away their old garments of fig leaves. The "<u>new garments</u>" made by the Lord were "<u>coats of skins</u>". An animal <u>had to die</u> in order to provide them with "<u>new garments</u>".)

PRO 27:26 The lambs are for thy clothing, and the goats are the price of the field. (Jesus The Lamb had to die to provide us with "New Garments".)

GEN 35:2 Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments:

(We need a "change of garments" but we can't make "new garments" for ourselves - only Jesus can provide us with "New Garments".)

ZEC 3:3 Now Joshua was <u>clothed with filthy garments</u>, and stood before the angel. ZEC 3:4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, <u>Take away the filthy garments</u> from him. And unto him he said Behold, <u>I have caused thine iniquity to pass</u> from thee, and <u>I will clothe thee with change of raiment</u>. (Jesus will "<u>take away</u>" our "<u>filthy garments</u>" (our sins) and will clothe us with "<u>change of raiment</u>" or "<u>New Garments</u>" (<u>His Righteousness</u>).

(We can't "change our characters" (garments) but Jesus can change us.)

### The Clean and Fruitful Sheep

Song of Solomon - chapter 6

Verse 6: "Thy teeth are as a flock of sheep which go up from the washing, whereof every one beareth twins, and there is not one barren among them."

#### PHYSICAL

Let's think about this verse in the real or physical world first.

- 1. "<u>Teeth</u> are like a <u>flock of sheep</u>" a persons <u>teeth</u> are positioned <u>close together</u>. A flock of <u>sheep</u> stay <u>close together</u>.
- 2. When you look at a person's <u>teeth</u>, each <u>tooth</u> has a <u>twin</u>. "Everyone beareth twins", in the text each <u>sheep</u> bears <u>twins</u>.
- 3. Teeth are white. Most sheep are white.
- 4. <u>Teeth</u> get <u>dirty</u> and need "<u>washing</u>" or cleaning. In the text the <u>sheep</u> are <u>washed</u>. <u>Sheep</u> are actually "<u>dipped</u>" or <u>immersed</u> by running them through a trough like tank to wash or clean them.

   A <u>sheep</u> represents a <u>person</u>. Jer. 50:6. The <u>sheep</u> needed to be <u>washed</u> or <u>immersed</u>. So, like <u>sheep</u>, <u>people</u> need to be <u>washed</u> or <u>immersed</u> or <u>baptized</u> so they can be <u>spiritually clean</u>.
- 2. What else is <u>special</u> in the verse about the sheep? "not barren"-- "gives birth to twins" Barren means to have no children. So "<u>not barren</u>" would mean <u>to have children</u> or <u>baby sheep</u>".
- 3. What does a "child" or "baby sheep" represent? a new convert or spiritual baby.
- 4. Each "tooth" has a twin and each sheep has a twin. So, each "sheep" or person will go and teach another person and make a convert for Jesus.
- In Lesson 4 (about the Old & New Garments) we learned that we must give our life completely to Jesus and be converted.
- In Lesson 5 (about the Old & New Wine Bottles) we learned that we must be converted before we will accept Doctrinal truth.
- Now, Lesson 6 is teaching us that we <u>must be baptized</u> (washed) and then go and teach others or <u>make converts for Jesus</u>.







Paraphrase: A <u>Church</u> when she is in <u>labor to bring people to conversion</u> hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as spiritual birth or conversion occurs, she remembers no more the anguish, for joy that a man <u>has been converted or "born again</u>" into the Church.

<u>Summary</u>: Thus, Jesus was trying to tell His disciples, through the means of the "Acted Parable", that He had to leave them and return to Heaven, but while He was gone they had "work to do", to labor with people and bring them to conversion and into the Church.

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**INTRODUCTION:** The following study shows that Jesus did <u>not</u> put <u>His "private interpretation"</u> on the <u>real objects</u> he used in <u>His parables</u>, but rather, He "<u>searched the scriptures</u>" to determine their <u>spiritual meaning</u>.

The Bible clearly tells us that Jesus was "in <u>all things....made like unto his brethren.</u>" (Heb. 2:17) He <u>took not</u> on him <u>the nature of angels</u>; but he <u>took on him the seed of Abraham.</u>" (Heb. 2:16) Thus, <u>Jesus did not use His Divinity</u> for <u>Himself</u>, but would have had to <u>grow up and do things</u> as an <u>ordinary man</u> would do. This means that He would have had to <u>study the Scriptures like</u> an <u>ordinary man</u> would have to do <u>in order to understand them</u>. The Bible tells us that the <u>knowledge</u> or <u>wisdom</u> that Jesus possessed was <u>progressively obtained</u>.

"And the child (Jesus) grew, and waxed (1) strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him."

"And Jesus increased (2) in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." Luke 2:52

#### From Strong's Concordance:

- (1) Waxed #2901 Increase, be strengthened
- (2) Increased #4298 To advance, to grow

God already <u>has</u> all knowledge and wisdom. He doesn't "<u>increase in wisdom</u>" as the Bible stated about Jesus. Thus, Jesus could <u>not</u> have been using his divinity or "God nature", but rather he was using his "human nature" as he learned and <u>then</u> taught.

By the age of 12 years old (Luke 2:42), <u>Jesus</u> already had an "<u>astonishing</u>" <u>understanding of the Scriptures</u>. (Luke 2:47)

His understanding of the scriptures was far different than the PhD's in Religion of his day. (Luke 2:46, 47) (Matt. 7:29)

#### Jesus said:

"The <u>seed</u> is the <u>Word</u> of God." (Luke 8:11) How did Jesus know that?

By <u>comparing</u> the Old Testament <u>Scriptures</u>.

#### Seed

Psalms 97:11 "<u>Light</u> is <u>sown</u> for the righteous..."

Psalms 119:105 "Thy <u>Word</u> is...a <u>light</u> unto my path."

Eccl.11:6 "In the morning <u>sow</u> thy <u>seed</u>."

#### Conclusion:

"Light" is sown. But "light" is the Word.

Therefore, the Word is sown. Also the "seed" is sown.

Therefore, the "seed" is the Word which is sown. Just as Jesus said!!

Thus Jesus compared Scripture with Scripture in order to determine the Spiritual meaning of the real objects in the parable.

## The Parable of:

## "The Salt Of The Earth" (Matt. 5:13)

13 "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men."

In order to determine the (Spiritual) meaning of this parable we will have to "Compare Scripture with Scripture" to determine the (Spiritual) meaning of the real objects (salt).

Thus, when the Bible says that "salt" represents God's Law, it is saying that "salt" represents God's character. Similarly, when the Bible says that "salt" represents God's people, it is saying that "salt" represents the character of God's people.

In the parable the salt had lost its "savour" or lost its "character". Since salt represents God's people (ye are the salt), then the parable is saying that Christians can lose their "character" just like salt can. Since God's Law represents God's "character", when Christians stop obeying God's Law, they stop representing God's "character"! They no longer should be called "Christ"ians because they do not represent the "character" of Christ. They have lost their "savour"!

### Conclusions:

- 1. The literal meaning of the lost "savour," when used to describe the salt means to "become insipid." The dictionary defines "insipid" to mean something that is weak and characterless and applies the meaning to both food and persons.
- 2. The (Spiritual) use of the word "savour" describes how Christ's sacrifice and offering of Himself for us is as a "sweet smelling savour" to God. Then the Bible compares the "witness" that we give of the knowledge we have of Christ, to being a "sweet savour" to God.

## **Summary of Conclusions:**

When Jesus described the salt and said "Ye are the salt" and then went on to say that "if the salt have lost his savour," it was good for nothing, He was Spiritually saying:

## Paraphrase:

You are like salt. When salt loses its "savour" it becomes "insipid" or "weak" and loses the "character", that salt is known for, which is to permeate and influence and change whatever it is put into. If it doesn't do this, then it is good for nothing but to be thrown out.

Similarly, you like the salt can become "insipid" or weak and lose the "character" that Christians are known for, which is to witness about Jesus with their mouth and to represent Him in character by the actions of their life. If Christians don't do that, they are good for nothing but to be "cast out".

## "Butter and Honey Shall He Eat"

BIBLE VERSE: Isaiah 7:15

- Isaiah 7:15 Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and choose the good.

Eating Real or Physical Butter cannot help me to know how to choose between good and evil! Therefore, this Bible verse must be talking about Spiritual Butter and Spiritual Honey.

Let us "discover" what the Bible says that "Spiritual Butter" represents. But first we must learn how to study a "word" or subject in the Bible, so that we can "discover"—its Spiritual meaning.

## How to Study a "Word"in the Bible

## 1. Use Inductive Reasoning

## **Inductive Reasoning**

Inductive Reasoning is the process of <u>bringing</u> forward facts to prove something. It is the act or process of reasoning <u>from parts</u> to a <u>whole</u> or <u>general conclusion</u>. Many facts are examined, which apply to the subject being studied, in order to draw a <u>general conclusion</u> which is in <u>agreement</u> with <u>all</u> the <u>facts</u>.

## **Inductive Reasoning Applied to Bible Study**

Many texts of Scripture, which apply to the subject being studied, are examined in order to draw a general conclusion based on the harmony or agreement of all the many texts studied.

2. Think about <u>each text</u> first as to the <u>Physical meaning</u> and then apply the <u>Spiritual meaning</u> of the <u>real objects</u> in the verse.

Now that we know the "Rules", let us proceed to examine all the texts in the Bible that mention the word "butter".

## The Two-Edged Sword

In Class #8 we learned how to use Inductive Reasoning to examine Bible texts with the word "butter" to determine their Physical as well as their Spiritual meaning.

In Class #9 we are again going to use Inductive Reasoning to examine the phrase "Two-Edged Sword" and see if we can "discover" its Spiritual meaning as we "compare Scripture with Scripture".

1. Use Inductive Reasoning

Inductive Reasoning applied to Bible Study

Many texts of Scripture, which apply to the subject being studied, are examined in order to draw a general conclusion based on the harmony or agreement of all the many texts studied.

2. Think about <u>each text</u> first as to the <u>Physical meaning</u> and then apply the <u>Spiritual meaning of</u> the <u>real objects</u> in the verse.

Example: A Bible study of the "word" twoedged

A) "Word": Twoedged

B) Strong's Concordance lists the following texts in this order:

1. Psalm 149:6

3. Hebrews 4:12

2. Proverbs 5:4

- 4. Revelation 1:16
- C) There are only <u>four places</u> in the Bible where the "word" <u>twoedged</u> is used. We will <u>write out</u> the <u>full text</u> as given in the Bible and then <u>think about</u> each verse to discover the <u>most important fact</u> that each verse is revealing about the "word" <u>twoedged</u>. Then we will <u>write our conclusion</u> in <u>our own words</u>.



  - 1. The Bible is to be in our hand.
  - The <u>Bible</u> will end the power of the <u>false church</u>. (Because we will see the truth.)
  - 3. The <u>Bible</u> is the <u>twoedged</u> sword.

    (It is our powerful weapon to overcome evil.)
  - 4. The <u>Bible</u> has come from the mouth of Jesus Himself. (We can trust what Jesus has told us.)

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We have just learned that the "Two-Edged Sword" represents the Bible.

So, the <u>Bible warns us</u> that there will be False Churches
that will <u>counterfeit God's Words</u>
and even <u>counterfeit His Holy Spirit!</u>

The <u>Bible</u> also tells us <u>how to tell</u> if the Church is a False Church--by judging it by the Bible itself!

In other words, to Compare

the teachings of the <u>Bible</u> to the teachings of the <u>Church</u>.

## Discovering the <u>Hidden Treasure</u> in: "The 23rd Psalm"

The <u>23rd Psalm</u> has comforted people for many years. On the <u>surface</u> we cannot help but see <u>Gods' Love and Care</u> for us! But is there more, <u>below the surface</u>, that perhaps we have not seen as clearly?

Lets take a look at this beautiful part of the Bible and see what we can learn. First we will look at the 23rd Psalm Physically and then we will see what it is saying to us Spiritually

### The 23rd Psalm

- :1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
- :3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- :4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
- :5 Thou preparest a table in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
- :6 Surely goodriess and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

Now, lets see what God offers us "Physically."

On the <u>Surface of Scripture</u>, God wants to provide these <u>"Physical" things</u> for us:

- 1. Someone to care for us (shepherd)
- Assurance that our needs will be met (I shall not want)
- 3. A place to rest (lie down)
- 4. Food to eat (green pastures)
- 5. Guidance (leadeth me)
- 6. Water to drink (still waters)
- 7. Restoration of our whole being (restoreth my soul)
- 8. A path for us to follow (paths of righteousness)
- 9. Freedom from fear (I will fear no evil)
- 10. Friendship (Thou art with me)
- 11. Physical protection and security (thy rod and staff comfort me)
- 12. An invitation to dine with Him (thou preparest a table before me)
- 13. Oil to anoint our head with (thou anointest my head with oil)
- 14. A place to live, a full cup, and goodness and mercy all the days of our life.

Now, lets see what God offers us "Spiritually."

## The "Spiritual meaning of the 23rd Psalm

In order to determine the "Spiritual" meaning we must locate the Key words which are usually Real Objects and then discover their Spiritual meaning by using the Bible Word Pictures.

Since there are so many Key words in this Psalm, in order to save space, they will be listed and no Bible Word Pictures will be shown, but the <u>Bible Texts</u> will be <u>listed</u>.



## <u>Using the Concordance to</u> <u>Discover the "Plan of Salvation"</u>

At the very beginning of this class, in the Workbook, before class #1, we learned "How to use a Concordance" and how to discover the meaning of a word by using the Hebrew and Greek Dictionaries in the back of the Concordance.

By looking up the <u>meaning</u> of the <u>names</u> of <u>Adam and his nine</u> <u>descendents in their order</u> until the flood, we will discover the <u>Plan of Salvation!</u>

This remarkable illustration shows the <u>Divine Inspiration of the Bible</u>, very clearly! It also shows what a <u>LOVING GOD</u> we serve! 2 Timothy 3:16 - "<u>All scripture is given by inspiration of God</u>..."

The "chance" that these <u>names</u> just "happened" to be in the <u>right</u> <u>order</u> and just "happened" to have the <u>right meaning</u> is <u>beyond</u> <u>coincidence!</u>

Once again, we have seen an <u>astounding thing!</u> All 39 Books of the <u>Old Testament</u> are in the <u>exact order</u> and have the <u>exact meaning</u> to plainly tell us the <u>Story of the Plan of Salvation!</u>

In our very first lesson #1, we discovered the <u>Plan of Salvation</u> in the <u>Colors.</u>

Now, we have seen The Plan" in the Names of Adam and his Nine decendents and also in the Names and Order of the Books of the Old Testament.

The Bible Stories themselves also reveal the Plan of Salvation.

The story of Abraham and his willingness to sacrifice his only son, and Isaac's willingness to die, reminds us of Gods' willingness to give His only Son, Jesus and His willingness to die for us.

Jesus and His Father have <u>revealed their LOVE for US</u> so plainly, that as the Bible says, only

"The fool hath said in his heart there is no God."

If you have concluded that there is a God, what are YOU doing to show YOUR LOVE for HIM?

## ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLE OF UNDERSTANDING AN "ACTED PARABLE" THROUGH THE USE OF "KEY WORDS"

#### Acted Parable of: JESUS HEALING THE MAN WITH PALSY

MAT 9:2 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

Comment 1 In order to learn more about this man that was healed, we need to "compare scripture with scripture". To do this we locate a "Key Word" in the scripture we have started with and then using a Concordance we can discover other scriptures discussing the same subject.

#### Key Word: Palsy

MAR 2:2 And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive them, no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them.

MAR 2:3 And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the <u>palsy</u>, which was borne of four.

MAR 2:4 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof

where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

MAR 2:5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.

LUK 5:18 And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought means to bring him in, and to lay him before him.

LUK 5:19 And when they could not find by what way they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with his couch into the midst before Jesus.

LUK 5:20 And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.

Thus, by "comparing the scriptures" written by Mark and Luke we have discovered a lot more about this man with palsy.

Comment 2: In order to learn more about this man with Palsy, we could use the Greek Dictionary in the back of Strongs' Concordance and discover what kind of illness "Palsy" is.

Strongs'Greek Dictionary —Ref # 3885--paralutikos--paralytic from----Ref# 3886--paralyzed

Thus, the man with Palsy was Physically paralyzed (not able to physically move on his own)

<u>Comment 3</u>: <u>In order to learn still more about "Palsy"</u> we could again "compare scripture with scripture" and <u>look at other texts that talk about Palsy</u> besides the texts that describe the particular man and story in the above texts.

#### Key Word: Palsy

MAT 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

MAT 8:6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

Thus, Palsy was associated with devil possession or "being controlled by Satan".

## Summarizing What We Have Learned (on the surface of scripture about the Physical )

- 1. The man with <u>Palsy</u> was physically paralyzed and <u>not able to physically do</u> what he wanted to do.
- 2. Palsy was associated with devil possession or being controlled by the devil.
- 3. Four friends brought the man with Palsy to Jesus.
- There were many people that blocked the way as the four friends tried to bring their friend, the man with Palsy, to Jesus.
- 5. The four friends would not give up when people blocked their way. They went up on the roof and opened it so that they could bring their friend with Palsy, physically, to Jesus.
- 6. Because of the faith of the four friends, Jesus was able to physically heal the man with Palsy.
- 7. When Jesus healed the man with <u>Palsy He said</u>, "Thy sins be forgiven thee" instead of "thy illness be cured". This can only mean that He wanted us to consider the man as being <u>Spiritually healed</u> rather than Physically healed in this "Acted Parable".

Physical or Literal: On the surface of Scripture the words tell us what Jesus wanted to do Physically for the man with Palsy.

<u>Spiritual</u>: Below the surface of Scripture, the deeper hidden meaning, tells us what Jesus wanted to do <u>Spiritually</u> for the man with Palsy.

Summarizing What We Have Learned (below the surface of scripture about the Spiritual)

- 1. In the "Acted Parable" the man with "Palsy" represents a person who is "Spiritually Paralyzed" and not able to do what he wants to do Spiritually. In other words a typical human being like Paul who said "..how to perform that which is good I find not. For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do." Rom. 7:18,19
- 2. Spiritual Paralysis is associated with devil possession or "being controlled by the devil". We want to do good, but we can't by our selves, because the devil is too strong for us.
- 3. Friends can "bring a friend to Jesus", Spiritually, through prayer and Bible study.
- 4. As we try to "bring our friends to Jesus" by studying with them and praying for them, the devil will use many people to "block the way to Jesus".
- 5. We are not to give up when people block our way, but we are to continue to take our friends to the highest possible point heaven, through our prayers and Jesus will hear and answer them!
- 6. Because of our faith, Jesus will be able to heal our friend Spiritually and free them from the control of Satan!
- 7. Jesus will say "Thy sins be forgiven thee" and our friend will be Spiritually well, and able to do what he wants to do spiritually, with the Help of Jesus!!!

2.) Then, re-examine the Bible story by placing the word "spiritual" before each real object, and re-read the story.

3.) Now, <u>substitute</u> the "<u>spiritual</u>" meaning of <u>each real object</u> back into the story to see <u>spiritual truth</u>.

# Understanding an "Acted Parable" Using KEY WORDS Acted Parable of: "Jesus heals blind Bartimaeus"

Physical: On the surface of Scripture, the words of the "Acted Parable" tell us that a man who was physically blind called out to Jesus, as the "son of David", to heal him and give him physical sight. Jesus heard his call, and commanded him to physically come to Him. The blind man responded by casting his physical garment away and coming physically to Jesus. The blind man received the gift of physical sight from Jesus and physically followed Jesus in the way. It was the faith of the blind man that allowed Jesus to "make him whole".

Spiritual: Below the surface, the deeper hidden meaning, of the "Acted Parable" tells us: We are spiritually blind, without understanding of truth and without salvation. We need to "call out to Jesus", as the Light of this world, to heal us and give us spiritual sight. Jesus will hear our call and command us to "come to Him spiritually". As we respond and reject our sinful life, He will receive us and we will receive Jesus and the ability to understand truth! We are then to follow that truth, that Jesus, the Way, The Truth, and The Life, has revealed to us. By faith in Him, we will be given the gift of salvation and be made spiritually well.
